

NEW BRUNSWICK ASSOCIATION OF APPROVED BASKETBALL OFFICIALS (NBAABO) <u>New Member Application</u>

All individuals applying to become new members of NBAABO are required to complete the attached package. The following information, once completed, must be submitted to the local Zone Representative prior to officiating any games:

- New member application form (including written test score)
- New member application fees (cheques made payable to AABO Inc.)
 - Current CABO members transferring from another province: \$75
 - Non-members of CABO: \$30
- Criminal background check (including vulnerable sector search).

To obtain a criminal background check, applicants shall submit their completed new member application form along with the attached letter (completed by the local Zone Rep) to their local city police department or RCMP detachment.

Contact your specific Zone Representative for more information regarding clinics and schedules for the respective zone.

NOTE: Zone Representatives are responsible for forwarding all documentation and membership payments to the Secretary/Treasurer of NBAABO.

Criminal Record Search Policy

NBAABO owes a duty of care to its members and those within the basketball community. In an effort to protect the youth involved in the games we officiate, all members new to NBAABO as of September, 2013, are required to complete a criminal record search with their local police department. No new member's application will be accepted without these documents.

Any individual with past Criminal Code convictions for the following offenses will not be considered for membership:

- physical or sexual assault
- current prohibitions forbidding the individual to have contact with children under the age of 18
- indictable criminal offenses for child abuse
- sexual exploitation
- sexual interference
- invitation to sexual touching
- individual listed on the sex offender registry
- any violent offense, whether or not it involved a weapon

NBAABO will accept a criminal record search completed by an applicant within the past six months.
