

CASE # 1 :

A1 attempts a 3 point field goal. While the ball is in the air, B3 fouls A3. The try by A1 is successful. The foul by B3 is Team B's 5th team foul of the period.

QUESTION :

What procedure is to be followed ?

ANSWER :

Team A is credited with 3 points and A3 shall be awarded 2 free throws.

CASE # 2 :

A2 attempts a field goal and while the ball is in the air, B2 fouls A5. The try for goal then strikes the ring, but is unsuccessful. When the foul was called, there were 10 seconds on the shot clock. The foul by B2 is Team B's 2nd team foul of the period.

QUESTION :

What procedure is to be followed ?

ANSWER :

Team A shall be awarded a throw-in out of bounds at the spot nearest to the foul of B2. The shot clock shall be reset to 14 seconds.

CASE # 3 :

A4 attempts a field goal but the try is unsuccessful. After the ball strikes the ring, A2 in an attempt to get the rebound, bats the ball into Team A's backcourt where A1 is the first player to gain control of the ball.

QUESTION :

Is this a legal play ?

ANSWER :

The play shall continue without any interruption. When the ball is released on an attempt to score from the field, Team control for Team A ends. When A1 gains control of the ball, a new shot clock and backcourt count shall begin.

CASE # 4 :

Just prior to the start of the 4th period, Coach B is assessed a Technical foul. The AP arrow favours Team B.

QUESTION :

What is the correct procedure for returning the ball to play ?

ANSWER :

The foul on Team B's coach shall be inscribed as a Coach's or "C" foul. Team A shall be awarded one free throw plus a throw-in at the center line extended opposite the table. Any player on the roster shall be permitted to attempt the one free throw. The AP arrow shall not be affected and the next jump ball AP arrow throw-in shall be awarded to Team B.
